500m / 1600m / 5km

in YOUR community

(safely in your backyard, a nearby high school track, or a local park, with a member of your household)

Step One: Register online here

SOO Athletes: Enter Promo Code SOO at the top for a discounted “Going Virtual” entry (one entry for all distances)

The total cost is \$18.14

Register early to receive a Snowshoe Kawartha neck gaiter, bib number and prize draw ticket

Step Two: Complete your distances

- Use your own GPS or tracking app
- Your coach can inform you of a measured course or trail to use in your community
- A high school track is normally 400 metres: once plus the straightaway is 500m, four times around is 1600m, 12½ times around is 5km.
